Visit to **"Manzana de las Luces"** in Buenos Aires downtown

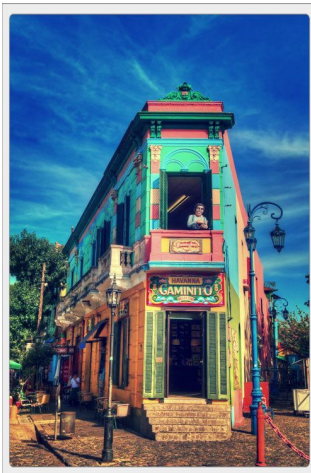
*The Manzana de las Luces, or block of enlightenment, is one of the main historic landmarks in Buenos Aires and home to some of the city's oldest constructions, including the Baroque San Ignacio church. The church was built by the Jesuit order of monks between 1686 and 1722, and followed by an adjoining school, museum, library, administrative offices and the city's first pharmacy,*

Optional: Attend Mass at San Ignacio Church at regular hours

*Athletic teams: Afternoon practice at local athletic grounds*
